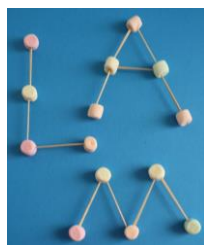

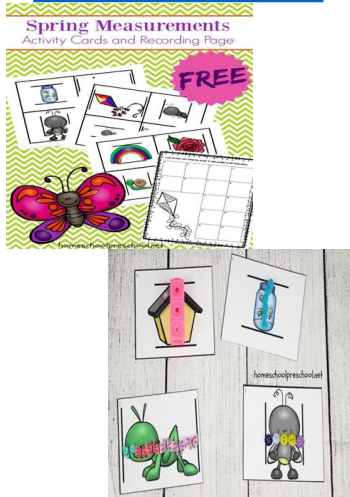
- After Reading:

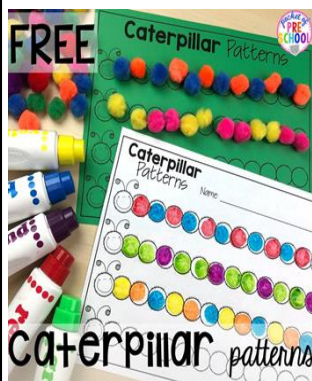

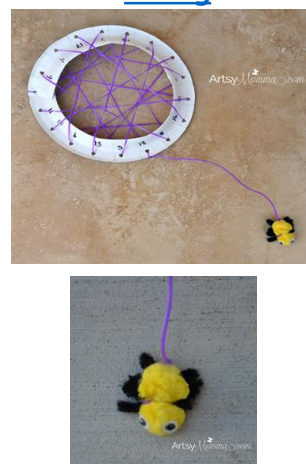

- Find something bigger than a TV remote but smaller than the couch.

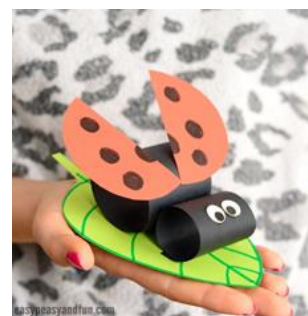
